Starting in 2017, the group was the recipient of a grant provided by the Arts Council for Long Beach. The funds were used for the art exhibit, "Pure Nature", at the Long Beach Playhouse. In November 2018, "Painting Long Beach" will be sponsored by The Port of Long Beach and will debut at the Long Beach Playhouse. Grants like these help to pay for publicity and advertising for local shows and to heighten community awareness.
